Study Programme and Mobility

The AMIR-EM programme is a **2-year full-time programme taught in English**. You have been selected to follow **Track 3, 'UM/TUDa'**. You will follow the **first year** of the programme at **University of Miskolc** in 2023-24, and the **second year** of the programme, at **Technical University of Darmstadt** in 2024-25. The Programme will start in September 2023 in **Miskolc**.

Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Label

The AMIR-EM programme is labelled as an Erasmus Mundus Joint Master (EMJM), within the framework of the Erasmus+ programme of the European Commission (EACEA) by whom AMIR-EM is funded.

AMIR-EM Annual Participation Costs (Tuition Fees)

As an Erasmus Mundus labelled and funded programme, we apply the Erasmus+ format of 'Programme countries' and 'Partner countries'*. Therefore the fees for nationals of Programme countries are 4500€/year, while for nationals from Partner countries they are 9000€ per year. As an EMJM self-funded student, the AMIR-EM Consortium has decided that you do not pay these fees.

Insurance conditions

All AMIR-EM students are provided with a comprehensive insurance package (covering health, travel and civil liability aspects) for the full duration of their studies within the AMIR-EM programme. Nevertheless, students are still advised to sign up for the national health insurance systems in the countries they will study in. Students of EU nationality are also advised to sign up for the European Health Insurance Card in their respective countries before departure.

Students going to Lisbon may also sign up for the free Portuguese national health insurance system, however special 'Student insurance' is required to cover accidents or health problems occurring on the NOVA University campus. The latter is covered by the AMIR-EM participation costs.

Visa

Unless otherwise specified, and according to their assigned year 1 host university, students of non-EU/EEA nationalities must apply to their nearest French/Portuguese/Hungarian Embassy or Consulate for a national Visa Type D (long-stay student visa). The Visa must allow multiple entries.

Please note that once a candidate is selected, his/her data may be used for the purposes of evaluating the AMIR-EM Program and will be made available to the European Education and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA), the Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) and the EIT Raw Materials, acting as stakeholders of the Program.
