Study Programme and Mobility

You have chosen to start the programme at **Wroclaw University of Science and Technology, Poland, enrolling in the Mining and Geology MSc programme.**

Regarding the mobility semester of the programme, you have selected to study at University of Miskolc in the winter semester 2024.

Funding

The TIMREX programme is labelled by the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) as part of the EIT Raw Materials Academy. This means all TIMREX students benefit from a 13,500€ EIT "AVSA" (Added Value Student Activities) grant. This grant can be used for all costs associated with your studies, including living costs, travel costs, and tuition fee payment. The expenditure does not require justification with supporting documents. In line with EIT rules, the grant must be paid out by the TIMREX programme during the calendar year following your recruitment.

Upon the signed Student Agreement between you and the TIMREX Consortium, the AVSA grant will be paid to you as follows during the 2024 calendar year:

- 3000€ until end of March 2024,
- 3500€ until end of June 2024,
- 3500€ until end of September 2024,
- 3500€ until end of December 2024.

Please note that once a candidate is selected, his/her data may be used for the purposes of evaluating the TIMREX Program and will be made available to the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) and the EIT Raw Materials, acting as stakeholders of the Program.
